

Driving restrictions, goods transport Ukraine

There are no driving restrictions on goods vehicles in Ukraine at night, at weekends or on public holidays.

Kiev

Since 1 May 2008, a driving ban has been introduced for trucks with a GVW of over 4.5t on the ring road around Kiev. This ban applies every day from 7:00 to 20:00.

Since May 2013:

HGVs in transit can go through the City by night time and use: av. Bazhana, South stream crossing Dniper river, Stolychne Shose, str. Akademika Zabolotnogo, Odeskaia place, Velyka Kiltseva Doroga, av. Palladina, str. Miska, Gostomelske Shose, Nova Doroga, Minskyi av., place of Shevchenko, str. Poliarna, str. Bohatyrska, Tulska place, av. Maiakovski, av. Generala Vatutina, Kerchenska place, str. Bratyslavska, av. Brovarskyi.

Vehicles with a GVW of over 4.5t: tractors, self-propelled machines and mechanisms are not allowed to go to the central part of the City, namely, in the limits: Povitroflotskyi Shliakhoprovid – str. Chernovola - str. Glybochytska – str. Verhnii (Nyzhnii) Val – str. Naberezhno-Khreshchatystka – Naberezhne Shose – av. Druzhby Narodiv – Moskovska place – Chervonozorianyi av. – Povitroflotskyi av.

International goods transport vehicles are allowed to enter the city of Kiev from 10:00 to 17:00 providing that a CMR document or a TIR carnet is carried on board of the vehicle and that TIR signs are displayed correctly on the vehicle.

Temporary summer restrictions

From 1 June 2015, when air temperature exceeds +28°C, traffic on motorways will be limited for vehicles with loads of more than 7t on a single axle and a total weight over 24t.

Special road signs will show when the driving restrictions apply. In most cases, such restrictions will apply since 9:00 and 10:00 till 21:00 and 22:00, but this will depend on each region's location.

Signposts on motorways will give restriction details and information on the parking areas.
