



Tolls/Road use charge, goods transport Belgium

The Belgian kilometre tax came into force on 1 April 2016.

To pay the tax, transport operators must obtain an OBU at one of the service points set up throughout Belgium and at its borders.

Transport operators must then complete the short registration process by scanning their vehicle's documents, entering the details onto the touch screen at the tollgate terminal, and by paying the security deposit directly (€135). Any OBU ordered online will be delivered by post after the order.

The user portal (www.satellic.be) provides each company with additional access to a secure, private and personalised area, where it is possible to register a company or vehicles, to order one or multiple OBU, to couple or uncouple OBU and vehicles, and to manage all of the company and vehicle details in a simple and accessible manner.

Additional information and assistance

OBU may only be collected one at a time from the service points.

A call centre is open to provide aid for users both when installing their OBU and for their registration on the user portal.
