

Customs formalities, goods transport Turkey

For the driver, the following documents are required:

- valid passport;
- visa (please click [here](#) for detailed and up-to-date information, as well as contact numbers to apply for visas);
- international driving licence;
- ADR certificate, in the case of dangerous goods transport.

For the vehicle, the following documents are required:

- vehicle registration certificate from the country of origin;
- green international insurance card (also covering Turkish territory situated in Asia). It is also possible to take out a third party insurance policy at the Turkish border;
- special permit issued by the General Directorate of Highways if the vehicle exceeds the maximum permitted weights and dimensions.

For the goods, the following documents are required:

- TIR carnet;
- CMR international consignment note;
- invoice and list of freight;
- sanitary or veterinary certificate, as the case may be;
- ADR classification notice, in the case of dangerous goods transport.
