

Customs formalities, goods transport Austria

The following documents are required:

For the carrier

EU licence, or bilateral or transit transport authorisation

For the driver

- · passport or identity card;
- · visa compulsory for nationals of certain countries;
- driving licence (a national or international licence is accepted, provided it complies with the specifications of the Geneva and Vienna Conventions);
- · driver attestation for non-EU drivers of EU-registered vehicles;
- · individual control book or tachograph disks.

For the vehicle

- · national vehicle registration certificate;
- green international insurance card (not necessary in cases of bilateral agreement) or conclusion of an insurance policy at the border;
- · technical inspection certificate.

For the transport operation

- CMR consignment note;
- TIR carnet or Community Transit Document. In the absence of either, the Customs office may issue a waybill against a security deposit equal to the amount of duty to be paid. If an Austrian forwarding agent, recognised as excise guarantor and able to complete a waybill for the goods, is entrusted with the customs formalities, the security deposit is not required.
