

## Customs formalities, goods transport Slovenia

**For the driver**, the following documents are required at the least:

- passport (with visa, if so stipulated in a bilateral agreement) or identity card (for citizens from neighbouring and EU countries);
- national or international driving licence;
- attestation from the owner of the vehicle that the driver is authorised to drive this truck and carry out this transport operation;
- certificate of employment;
- individual control book or tachograph covering at least the previous 6x24 hours (for vehicles of over 5t GVW).

**For the vehicle**, the following documents are required at the least:

- national or international vehicle registration certificate;
- green international insurance card;
- certified copy of the contract if the vehicle has been leased.

**For the goods**, the following documents are required at the least:

- CMR international consignment note or corresponding document;
- TIR carnet or other customs guarantee;
- description of goods and list of packages;
- authorisation for dangerous goods of classes 1 and 7;
- certificate of origin of goods carried, if imported;
- phytosanitary or veterinary certificate.
