1. ENFORCING AUTHORITIES

In the Czech Republic foreign road vehicles may be checked by: Police, Customs Authorities, District Supervisors

2. SANCTIONS IN CASE OF MISSING OR NON-COMPLYING DOCUMENTS

2.1 Foreign carrier's documents

2.1.1 <u>EU Licence, ECMT Authorisation, Bilateral or Transit Transport Authorisation</u>

person(s) sanctioned: carrier

• sanctions: fine up to CZK 750 000

(§ 35/2 and 3 of the Road Transport Act N° 111/1994)

compromise settlement: no, only before the departure

• other measures: entry prohibited without a licence. Repeated offences may

lead to a prohibition pronounced for a given period

2.1.2 ADR permit

person(s) sanctioned: carrier or sender

• sanctions: fine of up to CZK 1 000 000. The Czech police may impose

a fine of up to CZK 10 000 for any violation of the rules governing dangerous goods transport by road (§ 23/1f) and

2 of the Contraventions Act N° 200/1990)

compromise settlement: no information

other measures: entry prohibited without a permit

person(s) sanctioned: driver

sanctions: fine of up to CZK 10 000

2.2.3 AETR record sheet, tachograph discs, digital tachograph?

person(s) sanctioned: carrier, driver

• sanctions: fine of up to CZK 500 000, driver up to CZK 10 000 plus

penalty points or prohibition of driving from 6 to 12 months

(§ 35/2 of the Road Transport Act N° 111/1994)

compromise settlement: no information

other measures: depositing an amount may be required. In case of refusal,

the vehicle is immobilised

2.3.6 ATP certificate of compliance

person(s) sanctioned: driver, carrier

sanctions: fine up to CZK 500 000

compromise settlement: fine up to CZK 5 000 on the road

other measures: entry prohibited

Document on hire or contract, driver's employment contract

Fine up to CZK 30 000, Road Transport Act N° 111/1994

compromise settlement: no information
other measures: entry prohibited

2.4.5 Transfrontier movement of waste document (Basel Convention)

sanctions: entry prohibited

2.5 Excess load of foreign vehicle

person(s) sanctioned: carrier, driver

sanctions: fine up to CZK 500 000 (§ 42a/4c of the Law N°13/1997 on

surface communications)

compromise settlement: no information

• other measures: entry prohibited for vehicles whose holder refuses to pay a

tax relating to special road use; in case of axle pressure -

journey prohibited.

2.6 Third-party insurance

person(s) sanctioned: driver

sanctions: fine up to CZK 5 000
compromise settlement: no information

other measures: journey prohibited for the vehicle

2.7 Obligation to produce required documents

person(s) sanctioned: driver, carrier

sanctions: fine up to CZK 1 000 000

compromise settlement: it depends on type of document
other measures: at the border: entry prohibited

inside the country: journey prohibited

2.8 Obligation to submit to a decision to immobilise the vehicle

person(s) sanctioned: no information
sanctions: no information
compromise settlement: no information
other measures: no information

3. APPEALS AGAINST SANCTIONS

3.1 Appeals against sanctions pronounced by enforcing agents (police, customs, other)

- authority with which the appeal should be lodged: relevant authority
- time-limit to lodge an appeal: usually 14 days

3.2 Appeals against sanctions pronounced by an authority reviewing fines (minor offences)

- authority with which the appeal should be lodged: regional authorities, Ministry of Transport
- time-limit to lodge an appeal: regional authorities 15 days, Ministry of Transport 30 days

3.3 Appeals against sanctions pronounced by a court reviewing misdemeanours (serious offences subject to penal sanctions)

- authority with which the appeal should be lodged: the court
- time-limit to lodge an appeal: 15 -30 days (stated in the decision)

4. SANCTIONS IN CASE OF INCORRECT LOADING OR STOWAGE

person(s) sanctioned: driver, carrier

• sanctions: fine up to CZK 5 000

compromise settlement: no

• other measures: journey prohibited
