- 3. Placing new (joint?) offers and services on the market.








 - Standard-Tariff (value 10,- EUR/Mon.)
- Special conditions Taxi
 - 20 % discount
 - Cashless payment
- Free BahnCard 25 (German Rail)
 - Free of charge (value 62,- EUR/year)
