JOB SUMMARY:

The Manager is responsible for actively developing the IRU Academy activity in the Middle East region, in coordination with the Head of the IRU Academy and the Senior Adviser for the Middle East region.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Lead IRU Academy regional expansion strategies by creating and strengthening representativeness, advocacy and service offer;
- Lead the adoption of national road transport professional qualification framework by governments in the Middle East Region, in compliance with the IRU Academy model (IRU Academy eXaminer);
- Scope and support the capacity building process required to establish national road transport professional qualification quality insurance structure necessary to run IRU Academy eXaminer;
- Provide increased visibility to the IRU Academy and support the expansion of new Associate Training Institutes (ATIs), increase the number of accreditations and issuance of IRU Academy certificates and diplomas to make the IRU Academy known to the larger Road Transport Industry audience;
- Establish and maintain formal networks with key internal and external partners in order to stay informed on latest business developments to identify new market opportunities, and subsequently, developing marketing approaches whilst also compiling and implementing new IRU Academy solutions;
- Deliver communication and public relations events such as seminars and workshops, established in close cooperation with the IRU Communication team and relevant internal and external stakeholders;
- Identify and establish multilateral road transport projects, focused on the region and supported by international funding bodies, which directly support IRU Academy priorities in terms of improving quality, safety and transport efficiency;
- Direct and contribute to the preparation of market studies, business models, cost-benefit analysis, exploitation plans, deployment roadmaps and other relevant research and reports;
- Implement a continuous improvement cycle to drive consistent, effective, customer focused and best-in class training projects.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- University degree in Business Administration, Engineering, Training or any related field;
- Minimum 5 years of relevant experience in the training field; Knowledge of road transport and commercial vehicle technologies is a must;
- Experience working in international trade or transport organisations would be an asset;
- Excellent command of English and Arabic is a must. French and other languages would be an asset;
