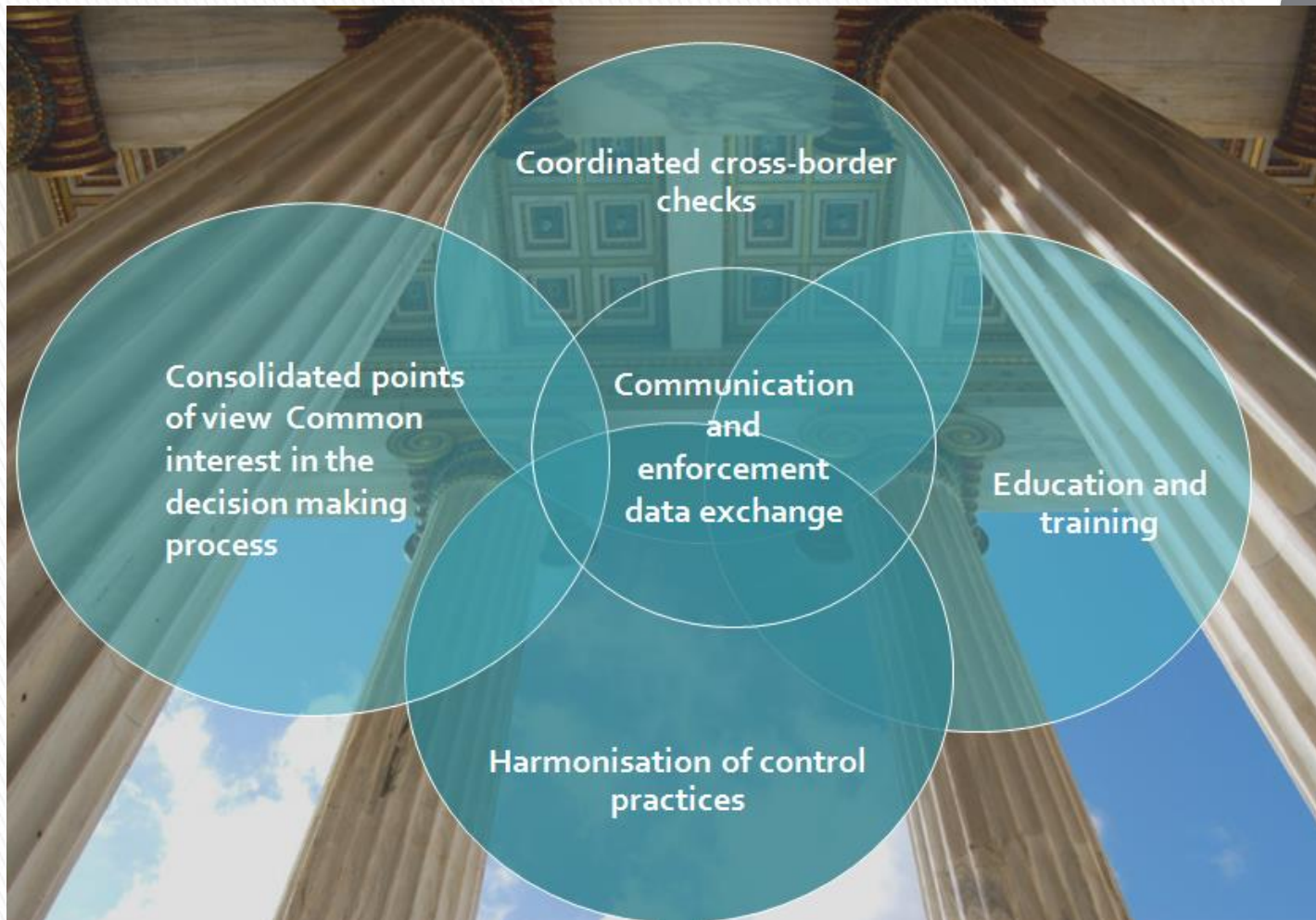

The five ECR pillars



Road transport situation in EU



- ▶ 80% loss enforcement capacity
- ▶ Resulting in 12^3 – 13^3 enforcers for 7^6 – 8^6 commercial vehicles (HGV's – PSV's)
(Enlargement of scope with LCV's pending)
- ▶ Old school enforcement 20th ➡ 21st century
- ▶ 20% – 30% tachograph frauds
- ▶ Wide spread Ad Blue fraud (emission fraud)
- ▶ Nomadic drivers / letter box companies



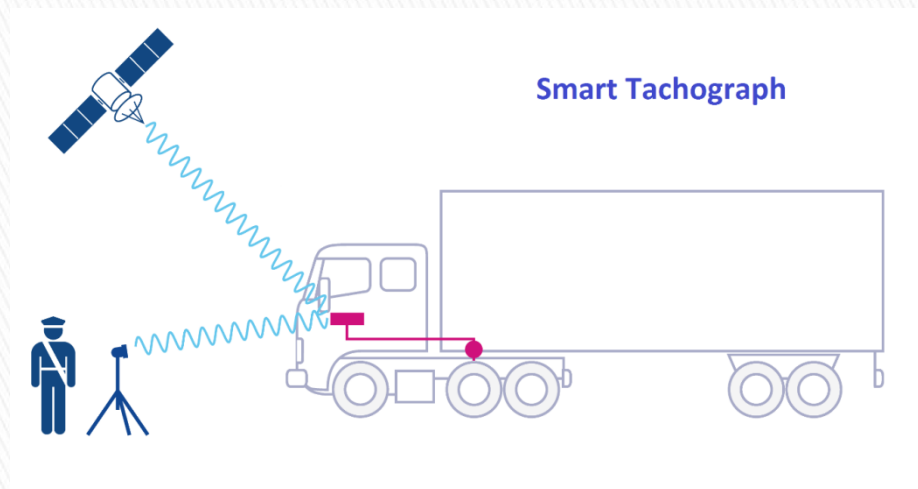
Smart tachograph as per June 2019



Road transport situation in EU



- ▶ Legislation 165/2014
 - smart tachograph (June 2019)
 - long implementation period DSRC
 - no retrofit obligation
 - GNSS potentially beneficial in fight against fraud
 - too late too little?



Road transport situation in EU



- ▶ The profession of driver has a negative image
 - driver shortage is effected by that too
 - professionalism goes hand in hand with good compliance
 - recruiting drivers from 3rd countries entails a risk



Enforcers view mobility package



► Mobility package

- Normal weekly rest in cabin (reference periods)
- Flexibility versus enforceability
- Retrofit?
- Tachograph used to enforce posting and cabotage rules (border crossing)



What about compliance?



Better enforcement fewer controls

- ▶ Good compliance record fewer/other controls
 - trust based enforcement
 - compliance performance based enforcement (Earned recognition) 
 - quality label scheme (public/private)
 - Information driven controls
 - enhanced communication industry & enforcers (manage the expectations)



What about compliance ?



- ▶ Flexibilisation of the legislation will be a challenge for enforcement and the industry
 - empathetic attitude enforcer and driver
 - discretionary versus black and white
 - legal certainty versus diversity in action

- ▶ Rewarding of good compliance should be better considered
 - based on risk scores
 - EU wide acceptation
 - distinctive quality characteristic
