Where did we start

- Increasingly fierce cost-based competition
- Illicit business and employment practices
- Proliferation of national measures on the application of minimum wages to foreign drivers
- Diverging control measures and administrative requirements on posting in road sector
- Administrative burdens and legal uncertainty

Regulatory response

- May 2017 – COM adopts a package of legislative proposals to address social, market and environmental challenges
- July 2020 – EU legislators adopt three legal acts on social and competition rules
- August 2020 – first batch of rules start applying (majority of driving and rest time provisions and tachograph requirements)
- February 2022 – second batch of rule swill start applying (posting, enforcement, market rules, incl. cabotage and stable establishment)

Preparatory work – non-regulatory

- Establishing guidelines (Q&A)
- Discussions with Enforcement Working Group
- Creation of the Expert Group on Posting of drivers
- Intensive work of the Expert Group on Safe and Secure Parkings
- Webinars, presentations, meeting with stakeholders
- Technical developments of IMI modules and of public interface
- TRACE 2 call for tender
- Your Europe

Preparatory work – regulatory

- Technical specifications on smart tachograph v2 – adopted in July 2021
- Classification of serious infringements
- Harmonized formula for risk rating systems
- EU standards for Safe and Secure Parking Areas – in adoption pipeline
- Functionalities of public interface connected to IMI – positive vote in October in adoption pipeline
- ERRU - revision

Internal Market Information system

- To facilitate administrative cooperation and exchange of information between MS
- Three modules: (1) posting, (2) stable establishment , (3) driving and rest times
- MS authorities end users
- MS to designate competent authorities for each module!

Public interface connected to IMI

- To facilitate sending electronically posting declarations by operators and exchange with host MS
- Multilingual for posting declarations and for communication
- Operators - end users
- Operator's profile – designate responsible person
- Prototype being prepared for hands-on testing
- Access may be granted in advance before 2 Feb'22 to allow creation of declarations
