JOB SUMMARY:

As part of the Strategy and Market Intelligence (SMI) team and in cooperation with internal stakeholders, the incumbent is in charge of coordinating the data analytics of IRU's Green compact and building internal intelligence on environmental data related to road transport.

The Green compact is a roadmap to carbon neutrality by 2050 for the road transport industry based on five pillars (alternative fuels, efficient logistics, collective mobility, efficient vehicles and driver training).

In this context, the incumbent will be responsible for supervising the collection of all environmental data-related analytics and research. S/he will ensure the robustness of the content and deliverables.

Analytics and data

Green compact project:

- Challenge and validate the data provided by the regional and technical experts, ensure the harmonisation of the methodology used
- Provide estimates based on modelling or engagement with external experts when missing points are identified
- Consolidate all data that will be used to establish and monitor the decarbonisation roadmap for the road transport industry, including forecasts for 2030, 2040 and 2050

Other:

• Build the data platform for the organisation on all topics related to the environment, using the Green compact and additional identified sources (members, corporates, industry organisations, research institutes)

Reports and deliverables

- Provide support on the Green compact reports, to ensure strong methodology and data robustness
- Make the links with IRU Intelligence Platform to offer additional content to members on the environment topic: suggest relevant data to be included on the platform, propose the layout and liaise with the project management team and IT

Management of external partners

 Identify and coordinate external partners for the Green compact project – consultants, data providers, universities : clarify the needs, identify the potential partners, select them based on expertise & cost and manage the partnership once it is in place
